REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION:

Minimum age of 16. **(Students under the age of 18 must obtain approval from BCSD)**

Students under the age of 18 must attend the Evening Program (Effective August 19, 2013)

CLASSROOM HOURS:

Day Program — Monday through Friday
9:00AM to 12:00PM

Evening Program — Monday, Tuesday
and Thursday 6:00PM to 9:00PM

PROGRAM LENGTH:

Length varies by student

\$30 Per Semester



GED FACTS:

Students that pass the GED® earn a Florida High School Diploma.

Test includes Reasoning through Language Arts (150 minutes), Mathematical Reasoning (90 minutes), Science (90 minutes), and Social Studies (90 minutes).

Can be earned in as little as one semester

Cost is \$32.00 for each subtest.
