REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION:

Minimum age of 18 years old.

Applicants 18 to 21 years of age are only permitted to operate intrastate (only in Florida) once licensed.

Participants must meet the Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) requirements to drive in Florida. Individual truck lines may have additional requirements.

Participants must be able to pass the D.O.T. physical requirements to be employable.

Applicants must have a Class “A” CDL training permit (no endorsements required).

Class “B” CDL training permit is required for Class B training.
