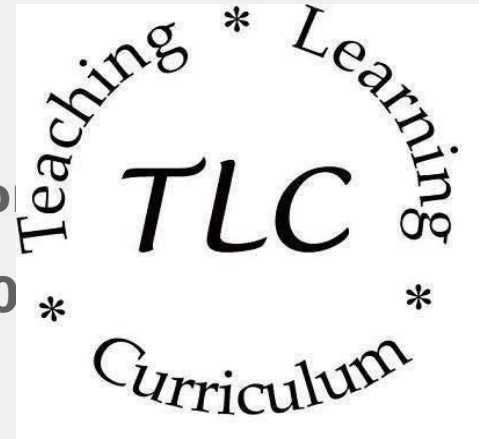

***Coursework begins January 5,
2021***

- ❖ Students will do all work online using the Edgenuity GENIUS platform.
Initial credit only
- ❖ Coursework is self paced and may be done at any time of the day. However - each semester course **MUST** be completed on or before the end of the semester.
- ❖ If a course is a full year course, it must be completed by the last day of school.
- ❖ State testing is still required. As of now, students **MUST** come in to take FSA / EOCs

- ❖ Families will work with school guidance counselors and Virtual Facilitator (Loper) to enroll and select courses
- ❖ Final grades will be entered into student transcripts. Track progress in Edgenuity and FOCUS.

Students should plan on working approximately 4 to 5 hours per day in order to stay on pace.

Getting started with SELECT

1. If you have not already done so, you must create a Parent portal in FOCUS and connect to your child's FOCUS account. Also make sure you know your child's school email address.
2. On Tuesday, pick up a chromebook (if needed) from your school site between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. At pickup, You will sign a security and safety use agreement for the chromebook.
3. Check your internet connectivity at home.

Parent and Learning Coach Resources

Parents and Learning Coaches are critical to virtual learning and provide a level of support for students. These resources will help you in understanding the roles, suggested schedules, and task management strategies

During online instruction each student will need the support of a Learning Coach, typically the parent or guardian who is present while the student is working at home. As students progress in their success with online learning there is an increase in independence.

The role of the Learning Coach includes but is not limited to:

- Guide the student through the lessons, tools, and games as needed
- Oversee assignments and help facilitate hands on learning

Getting started with SELECT

You will receive an email upon approval to begin. (3 - 5 days turn around)

MONITOR your progress! Generally, students complete at least 15% of coursework with a passing grade within the first two weeks of the course beginning.

If a student feels this is not the best option after all, he/she has until January 22 to return to brick and mortar.

The virtual coordinator will also be monitoring progress, and will be available to provide guidance on the learning options.
